FLOOD CWF[®] MULTI-SURFACE Waterproofing Clear Sealant

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

A clear waterproofing sealant that protects against moisture damage. Recommended for use on properly prepared exterior surfaces such as concrete, stucco, masonry, grout, mortar, terrazzo, wood, wood shingles, pressure treated wood, wood decks, outdoor wood furniture. DO NOT use on plastic, rubber, vinyl, tile, asphalt, or any sealed, nonporous surface. A test application is required to ensure proper absorbency. See **PRETEST** section on back page.

COVERAGE: One gallon (3.78 Liters) will normally cover 100 to 150 sq. ft. (9.3 to 13.9 sq. meters) on highly porous surfaces; 250 to 350 sq. ft. (23.2 to 32.5 sq. meters) on less porous surfaces. Coverage will vary due to porosity and texture of wood and application technique.

DRYING TIME: Normally dries to the touch in four hours when applied in optimal temperatures of 50°F to 90°F (10°C to 32°C). Application in high humidity or in temperatures below 50°F (10°C) may prolong drying time. Allow 24 to 48 hours of drying time before light foot traffic and 72 hours before replacing furniture. Allow new stain to cure 30 days before washing.

To Recoat: Wet-on-wet before first coat has dried For Pedestrian Service: 24-48 hours

Drying times listed may vary depending on temperature, humidity, film build, color and air movement.

CLEANUP: Clean brushes and tools with warm, soapy water.

DISPOSAL: Contact your local environmental regulatory agency for guidance on disposal of unused product. Do not pour down a drain or storm sewer.

GENERAL SURFACE PREPARATION

Surface must be clean. Remove all dust, dirt, mildew, oil, loose material and other contaminants. Use *FLOOD* Wood Stripper to remove any previous coatings. Previous coatings must be completely removed. To ensure proper adhesion, weathered, dirty or mildewed surfaces should be cleaned with *FLOOD* Wood Cleaner prior to applying product. Remove grade stamps or pencil marks by sanding. After cleaning, product can be applied directly to damp surface. New concrete must be allowed to cure for one month prior to application.

WARNING! If you scrape, sand, or remove old paint, you may release lead dust or fumes. LEAD IS TOXIC. EXPOSURE TO LEAD DUST OR FUMES CAN CAUSE SERIOUS ILLNESS, SUCH AS BRAIN DAMAGE, ESPECIALLY IN CHILDREN. PREGNANT WOMEN SHOULD ALSO AVOID EXPOSURE. PRETEST: To ensure proper penetration, apply on a small area before treating the entire surface. If product is not quickly absorbed into the surface, the surface is not suitable for application.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Apply when no precipitation is expected for 48 hours, and when air and surface temperatures are 50°F to 90°F (10°C to 32°C) and will remain above 50°F (10°C) for the next 48 hours. Avoid staining in direct sunlight or on hot surfaces. DO NOT THINOR MIX WITH ANY OTHER COATING, PAINT OR STAIN PRODUCTS. Stir thoroughly before using. Application by brush is recommended. May be applied roller, dipping, low-pressure garden-type sprayer or with spray equipment. When applying by roller or spray, always back-brush for best results. To help avoid lap marks, apply to only a few boards at a time, and maintain a wet edge. Do not saturate or puddle on horizontal surfaces.

LIMITATIONS OF USE

While this product provides a mildew resistant coating, growth may still occur if the substrate is not properly prepared prior to painting and/or if the substrate is consistently exposed to conditions conducive to mold, mildew, and algae. Examples of these conditions include, but are not limited to, under eaves, behind shrubbery and trees, and in areas that are consistently damp with little to no direct sunlight. FOR EXTERIOR USE ONLY. **PROTECT FROM FREEZING**.

PRECAUTIONS
